6. Property Report provided by P Prior:

1. Disabled spaces and car park - Camis job 126477 is with Council to mark 3 x disabled spaces in the car park so there is sufficient room for wheelchair users. This is within government guidelines for the size of car park. A quote is being sent as BCCA will have to fund this work ie Council will do work and we pay them.

2. Car park paving and tarmac quality. The Council has greatly improved and renewed the paving slabs in front of disabled area and to the side of the Centre so making access much

easier (Camis job 120780). The surface is gritty and so not ideal for wheelchair users but relaying the tarmac to a higher standard would cost a considerable amount and so is unlikely to be considered by the Council.

3. Car park - pothole now filled at entrance - at least for now!

4. Radiators in committee rooms and reception now working. Council engineers decided it was down to trapped air in the system.

5. Leak in men's changing room ceiling and in committee rooms ceilings now fixed so Andrew Millar joiner asked to fill the hole in the changing room ceiling, paint white the 2 x skylights in committee room and replace 10 approx missing or damaged ceiling tiles in the committee rooms.

6. Website - we need to renew updates and support/admin from February for a year - awaiting invoice from supplier.

7. Leak in wall at front of Centre from overflow pipe in gents changing room - Camis ref 127464.

8. Main Hall floor - contacted Hume Flooring of Falkirk to get quote for clean/varnish for summer before BCC 50th celebration in November.

7. BCCA 50th Anniversary

The BCCA 50th Anniversary subgroup presented a list of ideas for celebrating the 50th anniversary of the Community Center. The ideas were discussed and a number will be taken forward.

It is proposed to have a celebration event on the evening of Saturday 30th November. Everyone is asked to propose guests that might be invited along to this event. Suggested guest list: current Committee members, past office bearers, representatives from current groups using the Center, local supporters.

AOCB:

Hall insurance has been reviewed and will be updated. We do not need cover for employee liability or freezer cover.

It was noted that the number on the defibrillator was not very clear. L Hutchinson will investigate this.
